Browsing through hours of video data to retrieve useful information is a tedious and boring task. To address this issue, video summarization has played a crucial role towards making this possible.

This workshop aims to call for researchers with a relevant background to focus on novel solutions for user-centric narrative summarization of long videos. The goal is to provide the users with meaningful information and insights from long input videos, potentially captured from multiple cameras.

Topics of Interest include, but not limited to:

- Summarization of single/multiple long videos
- Action and scene graph generation from videos
- Narrative summary and video storytelling
- Datasets for long video summarization
- Novel evaluation criteria/metrics
- Novel application of long video summarization
- Open challenges in video summarization
- Privacy preserved video summarization
